

Patient instructions preparing for a gastroscopy

Gastroscopy means the examination of the esophagus, stomach and small intestine with a flexible endoscope. The examination is performed with the patient lying on their left side. The examination takes around 10 minutes. During the endoscopy, mucous membrane samples are taken; taking the samples is painless.

Preparing for the examination

Do not eat for at least 6 hours or drink for 2 hours before the examination.

After the endoscopy

Do not eat or drink anything hot for two hours.

If you are taking

- 1. Marevan: take the medication as usual according to the current instructions. Take an INR blood test 1-2 days before the examination. The referral is ready at the laboratory.
- 2. Pradaxa, Eliquis, Lixiana and Xarelto should not be taken on the morning of the examination.
- 3. Other medications taken regularly may be taken normally, but at least two hours before the examination.
